My next book about the Smithfield Martyrs, to be called <u>The Burning Time</u>, will be published in 2017 by St Martin's Press and Macmillan. I have also co-authored several books on church management and administration (e.g. <u>The Parish Survival Guide</u>, SPCK, 2004), and review books on a freelance basis, particularly for the Financial Times.
